

Trash to Fashion Show

Do you love fashion? Do you care about the environment? Then get creative and turn some trash into fashion! GSOH will be having a recycled fashion show at this year's Mall Lock-In and we want you to show us your best recycled outfits!



Guidelines:

- At least 1 article of clothing must be made of least 75% recycled or reused materials that otherwise would be thrown away or recycled. (examples– bags, newspapers, plastics, paper cartons, etc)
- No more than \$5 can be spent on your recycled garment. You may use new materials for construction such as glue, tape, marker, thread, zippers, etc.
- You may use old clothes but **MUST** change the basic structure (for example- a shirt can become a hat, pants can become a top, etc.)
- You may make accessories in addition to your article of clothing.
- You can work together on an outfit but only the person modeling the outfit will go down the runway at the show.
- Outfits must be constructed well enough to fit the model and hold together for the show.
- **Your entry form and your sketch must be to council by March 1, 2012 to be considered for the show.** Not all entries will be in the show.

Spaces are limited! Participants will be chosen based on the percentage of recyclable materials used, creativity, and originality. If the design is not chosen for the show, the sketch may be chosen to be displayed at the Mall Lock-In. Inappropriate designs will not be chosen or displayed.
