- TITLE:** In-School Scouting Facilitator
- PURPOSE:** To work directly with students in assigned Columbus City Schools to provide the In-School Scouting program of the Simon Kenton Council, BSA and Girl Scouts of Ohio's Heartland Council, Inc.
- ACCOUNTABLE TO:** Tonya Sharp, In-School Scouting Coordinator
- QUALIFICATIONS:** High School Diploma or equivalent
United States citizenship or declared intention to become a U.S. citizen
Adult—must have attained age 21 unless prohibited by any applicable law
People-oriented, having the ability to work well with school administrators, teachers and staff
Able to work varied hours when necessary to achieve positive objectives
Must have a valid driver's license and must be insured to drive
Must adhere to a criminal background check
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** Facilitators deliver module presentations that are developed using curriculum from the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts programs aligned to the Columbus City Schools core Curriculum Standards.
- Facilitator responsibilities also include:**
- Understanding and operating within Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts program guidelines, following established policies, standards, and procedures to provide an informal value-centered educational program.
 - Follows Columbus City Schools' regulations and guidelines when facilitating in schools.
 - Promotes through ISS modules presentation, positive social goals and opportunities to make ethical decisions.

- Promptly and properly secures student demographic rosters to register students as members of either the Simon Kenton Council, Boy Scouts of America or Girl Scouts of Ohio's Heartland Council, Inc.
- Understands and utilizes program materials to provide a balanced scouting program.
- Share lessons plans with classroom teachers.
- Contribute to a positive Boy Scout and Girl Scout relationship with the Columbus City School personnel.
- Promotes with the boys, girls and parents, Cub Scout and Girl Scout opportunities beyond the classroom.
- Participate in staff development and attends regularly scheduled meetings for program updates.
