Although some Pick-A-Programs may span a number of grades, your group of seven to 25 girls will have the program tailored to their age level. Individual Girl Scouts and their adult are welcome to join together with another group to participate in a Pick-A-Program. Note: All girls coming to Pick-A-Programs must come with their own supervising adults. A minimum of two supervising adults must accompany each troop. One supervising adult must accompany individuals. No tagalongs.

Most Pick-A-Programs take place outdoors rain or shine and are rarely canceled due to weather. Accommodations will be made based on current conditions. Come dressed for being outside.

Who can attend: Girl Scouts of Ohio's Heartland program events are available to all registered Girl Scouts. Girls ages 5 to 17 who are not currently registered Girl Scout members are welcome to sign up for an event and pay the \$12 membership fee in addition to the event fee. (Girl Scout membership is paid once a year.)

How to sign up: Complete the Pick-A-Program registration form on page 42 and **mail it directly to the address given on the registration form for that Pick-A-Program site. Do not send money at this time.** You will receive an invoice with your placement information.

Cancellation and refund policy: Contact the location directly to cancel. Refund requests must be submitted in writing and received 10 business days or more BEFORE the event to receive a refund. Ten percent of the fee paid will be retained as a handling charge. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER THE DEADLINE DATE.**

All About Birds Interest Project Patch (K-JE)

Grades: 6-12

Length of program: 3 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Learn about birds and their ecology. Girls will learn to identify birds by basic characteristics and participate in a bird identification hike.

Archery (K-JE, ML)

Grades: 4-12

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Learn how to safely and properly hold a bow, shoot an arrow, and aim for the target. An experienced archery instructor will help you build your skills and get closer to a bulls-eye. Seasonal program.

Animals Try-It (K-JE)

Grades: 1-3

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Explore the world of animals!

Art to Wear Try-It (K-JE)

Grades: 1-3

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Creativity is our theme during this art inspired program. We will create t-shirt art, have a face-painting party, make jewelry and more! Be sure to bring a plain white t-shirt of your own to design.

Backyard Wildlife (K-JE)

Grades: K-1

Length of program: 1.5 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

A beginner's nature hike through the habitats of camp. We will look for signs and tracks of animals on their home turf. Girl will get to know their wild neighbors, go on a scavenger hunt and learn how to attract wildlife to their own backyards. Program includes an indoor craft and outdoor exploration time.

Bath 'n Body Works for the Horse (LVR)

Grades: 5-12

Length of program: Overnight, 7:00 p.m. day 1 to 4:00 p.m. day 2

Cost: \$50/girl includes troop camping fee. No fee for non-riders. Meals not included.

Max/Min: 18/4

Camp overnight at LakeView Ranch and learn what it takes to care for a horse. The program begins with a barn orientation and a ground lesson. Then it's on to feeding the horses, participating in a riding lesson, and learning all about the care of a horse including how to bathe a horse.

Grades: K-4

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Get a taste of camp by making your own ice cream. Then, take a nature hike around camp and play a game on the camp lawn.

Camping Interest Project Patch (K-JE)

Grades: 6-12

Length of program: 3 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Plan and practice for a primitive camping trip for you and your friends.

Canoeing (CLLC, K-JE)

Grades: 4-12

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

A two-hour beginner's workshop in canoeing and small craft safety. Seasonal program.

Canoe Clinic (ML)

Grades: 5-12

Length of program: 3-4 hours

Max/Min: 10/6

Cost: \$12/girl

Designed for the beginning canoers who want to spend 3-4 hours working on canoeing skills and learning safe use of canoes and equipment. Learn basic paddle strokes for maneuvering the canoe then join in fun games to practice your new skills! This could be part of a fun weekend of troop camping at Camp Molly Lauman.

Challenge Course (CLLC, K-JE)

Grades: 2-12

Length of program: 2 hours, 3 hours for Teens

Cost: \$8/girl

Take advantage of the low ropes course to build teamwork in your troop that will last all year. Various team-centered challenges like the Giant Spider Web will push your troop to communicate and accept ideas from others while promoting cooperation and leadership. Elements available include the Croc Pit, Mohawk Walk, and Swamp Crossing.

Grades: 5-12

Length of program: TWO overnights, 7:00 p.m. of day 1 to 1:00 p.m. of day 3, no meals provided

Max/Min: 18/4

Cost: \$90/girl

Have you come to our Bath & Body Works program and couldn't get enough? Well, join us for Part 2! In this extended edition, you will stay for two nights and enjoy more time on horseback – possibly going on a short trail ride. Also, we will dive further into the world of horse care and learn how to “make over” a horse.

Fashion Bracelets (LVR) 🍀

Grades: 1-6

Length of program: 2 hours

Max/Min: 12/5 If there are more than 12 girls, please schedule an additional session.

Enjoy one hour at LakeView Ranch stamping and painting your own creative design into a leather bracelet that is yours to keep. This program is great combined with other horseback riding, or while camping at Molly Lauman.

Fillies & Flicks (LVR) 🍀

Length of program: Overnight, 6:00 p.m. of day one to 11:30 a.m. of day 2

Grades 6-12

Length of program: 2 hours

Enjoy one hour at LakeView Ranch and get familiar with the horses at this non-riding program. Come and give our horses some TLC while learning how to be safe when on the ground working with them. This is a great program to do before or with an Introductory Pony Ride.

Hiker Badge (K-JE) 🍀

Length of program: 2 hours

This program is a great introduction to hiking, including safety, equipment, do's and don'ts, and how to prepare for an all day hike.

Hi Tech Treasure Hunt (CLLC) 🍀

Grades: 4-12

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Learn what it means to “triangulate” as technology helps you get to the treasure. You will learn all about Geocaching and GPS technology on this fun hike through the woods.

Horseback Rider Badge (LVR) 🍀

Grades: 4-6

Length of program: 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Cost: \$40/girl (includes badge). Lunch not provided. No Cost for non-riders.

Max/Min 18/4

Come and spend 5.5 hours at LakeView Ranch working to complete your Horseback Rider badge. Participants bring their own sack lunches and drink.

Horse Sense Interest Project Patch (LVR) 🍀

Grades: 7-12

Length of program: 2 separate 5.5 hours visits to complete the Interest Project patch.

Cost: \$80/girl for both sessions

Max/Min: 18/4

Come to LakeView Ranch for 2 separate 5.5 hour day visits to work on your Horse Sense Interest Project patch. If you attend both Horse Sense 1 and 2, the entire IP will be earned. Participants bring their own sack lunch.

Horse Show Performance (LVR) 🍀

Grades: 6-8

Length of program: Overnight, 7 p.m. day 1 to 4:30 p.m. day 2

Cost: \$50/girl includes camping Cost, no meals provided. No Cost for non-riders.

Max/Min: 8/4

Camp overnight at LakeView Ranch and create your own live horse show, including music and decorating the horses. We will begin by learning some formations on the ground and then move to riding the horse through the same formations. Right before the show, we will decorate horses with glitter and braid their manes and tails.

Ready, Set, Go Camping Try-It (K-JE) 🌿

Grades: 1-3

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

A campfire, roasted marshmallows, sleeping in a tent, exploring the woods. What does camping mean to you? This will help get you started.

Ring & Trail (LVR) 🌿

Grades: 6-12, must meet pre-requisites

Length of program: 3.5 hours

Cost: \$55/rider. No Cost for non-riders.

Max/Min: 8/4 Note: It is possible to schedule more than 8 girls, but it will take 2 separate trail rides.

Prerequisites:

1. Ability to mount and dismount without assistance or aids.
2. Previously attend Horseback Ridge Badge and Bath 'n Body Work at LakeView Ranch, or equivalent experience.

Enjoy 3.5 hours at LakeView Ranch. We will start off with a refresher ring lesson. Then for those who are ready, we will hit the trail. Bring a snack and filled water bottle because we will stop for a short time while on the trail. Adults with the troop are welcome to participate but must be comfortable on/around horses and be able to mount/dismount without any assistance or aids. Girls will be placed first.

Rocks Rock Badge (K-JE) 🌿

Grades: 4-6

Length of program: 2 hours

Cost: \$8/girl

Get your fingers dirty, study fossils and start your own rock collection.

Space Exploration Interest Project Patch (K-JE) 🌿

Grades: 6-12

Length of program: 3 hours

Length of program: 2 hours

The Great Outdoors (K-JE) 🌿

Grades: K-1

Length of program: 1.5 hours
