Explore science, technology, engineering and math in a hands on way.

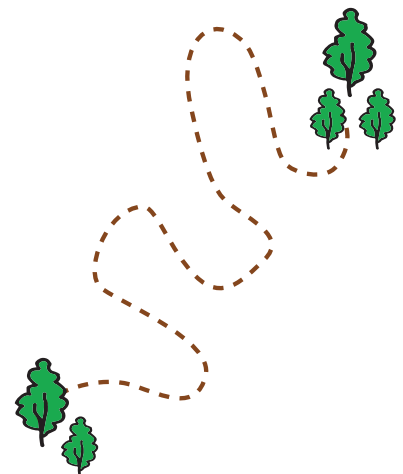
